

# How to check if there is any error in the battery panel

How do I know if my laptop battery is bad?

Check the battery's device status in Device Manager. This isn't really a fix, but more of a check to see if Windows has identified a problem with the battery. To do this, expand the Batteries category, then right-click your laptop's battery (e.g., Microsoft AC Adapter) and select Properties.

How to fix no battery detected on a Windows laptop?

This should be the first and the foremost step in fixing the issue of No battery is detected on a Windows laptop. The power adapter may be either loose or not working. Check if the laptop is charging with another power adapter. Read: [How to fix Battery drain issues](#).

How do I fix a laptop battery error message?

Update the battery's device drivers to clear the error message. One way to do this is through Device Manager. From the Batteries section, right-click your laptop's battery name and select Update driver. Another method is to use a driver updater tool.

How do I know if my battery is bad windows 11?

Windows 11 troubleshooters are in Settings > System > Troubleshoot > Other troubleshooters. Check the battery's device status in Device Manager. This isn't really a fix, but more of a check to see if Windows has identified a problem with the battery.

How do I know if my Dell laptop has a battery?

If the laptop is connected to an electrical outlet, the power or battery light operates as follows. For specific information about your Dell laptop, see the User Manual of your Dell laptop. Breathe white (slow increase and decrease in illumination). If the laptop is running on battery power, the power or battery light operates as follows.

Why is my laptop battery not detected?

No battery is detected. Battery #1: Not present. Consider replacing your battery. The battery is not detected. No battery present. Laptop battery not detected error messages are usually triggered by physical damage to the battery or laptop hardware, out-of-date drivers or other software, or overheating.
