

How to remove the battery when there is an external power supply

How do you remove a battery from a power supply?

Open the front cover of the Power Supply with Battery Backup (A), the battery operates at 12V-DC, which is safe for disconnection and handling. Disconnect the red '+' plug from the battery (B). Push the tabs holding the battery, one above and one below, outward and then lift the battery out (C).
