



How to remove the covered battery panel

How do you remove a car battery?

The most common location for a battery is in the front driver's-side corner of a car. Pull up on the latch on the side of the boxlike cover; the plastic should come free. Then lift the cover straight up and off the battery. Avoid touching the battery itself, especially if it is cracked or leaking.

How do you replace a car battery?

If you want to replace the battery in your car or examine it for cracks or leaks, you may need to remove the cover first in order to access the battery itself. Park your car and put it in "Park" if it is an automatic or first gear if it has a manual transmission. Place the parking brake on in order to secure the car while you work under the hood.

How do you clean a battery terminal?

Wire Brush: A wire brush is handy for cleaning corrosion off the terminals before reconnecting them. **Baking Soda and Water:** This mixture helps neutralize any acid spills around the battery area, making it safer to work. **Battery Terminal Cleaner:** A specialized cleaner can help remove corrosion quickly and efficiently.

How do I fix a bad battery?

Reattach the hold-down clamps: If your battery has hold-down clamps or brackets, secure them tightly with your wrench. **Check the terminal connections:** Ensure you tightly connect the positive and negative cables without any wiggle room, as loose connections can cause electrical issues later.

Remove and discard the old top plastic cover by peeling the plastic cover and butyl adhesive off from the top of the HV battery. Do not attempt to reinstall the plastic cover once it has been removed from the vehicle; the plastic cover is unable to make a complete seal after it has been removed from a Battery.

Quickly inspect the old battery. If the battery looks abnormal (i.e. has a swollen or split case, liquid leaking from the case, or corroded terminals) close the touchscreen and use the Live Chat button in the bottom right corner of the page to schedule a service call. NOTE: The battery pack is located inside the touchscreen. The battery pack has black and red wires coming out of it with a modular connector at the end. CAUTION: Do not remove the green plastic cover from around the new battery pack. This covering is necessary for a proper connection and may cause serious injury or damage if removed or damaged.
