In turn, the inverter converts direct current into alternating current with characteristics similar to the electrical grid. A small PV system is capable of providing enough AC electricity to power a single home, or an isolated device in the form of AC or DC electric.

Solar energy is a form of energy which is used in power cookers, water heaters etc. The primary disadvantage of solar power is that it cannot be produced in the absence of sunlight.
