

## The power and battery lights are yellow but the machine does not turn on

Why does my PC not turn on if Power Light is on?

When you're trying to fix the PC won't turn on but power light is on issue, you should eliminate all peripheral devices that may lead to the malfunction. If you keep finding your computer fails to start, disconnect everything and reboot the PC with just the keyboard and mouse.

Why does my PC not turn on but motherboard light is on?

What does a blinking light on a Dell laptop mean?

A blinking LED light could also signal problems with your laptop's Complementary Metal-Oxide Semiconductor (CMOS) battery.

If your laptop doesn't turn on when charging or on battery power, the troubleshooting steps below should get it working again. 1. Disconnect External Accessories. 2. Check Indicator Lights for Hints. 3. Charge the Laptop. 4. Reinsert or Replace the Battery. 5. Leave Your Laptop to Cool. 6. Increase Screen Brightness. 7. Wake Your Laptop's Screen.

If it powers up, the battery is likely your issue. Check for visual signs of battery age, swelling, or leak. Swollen batteries may manifest as difficulty in using the trackpad or the keyboard.

If it does, return the 24 pin and CPU power and we'll turn our attention back to the motherboard and remaining components.
